- Have an overall grade point average of 2.5
- Be proven leaders in any extracurricular activity, academics and in the community

- Behave in a way that brings integrity to self, family, school, and team(s) and are also in alignment with the memorial scholarship values (Faith, Family, Friends)
- Submit one letter of recommendation from a high school counselor, coach, teacher or administrator on school letterhead or a clergy member
- Submit a compelling story
- Complete the attached application
- Submit high school transcript

The compelling story should include how the candidate has endured a personal setback or persevered through any type of adversity. Include what happened, the outcome, what was learned and how you moved forward. Also include how faith, family and friends have played a role in your life.
